

## How to access and keep your notations in *Compass*<sup>™</sup>

*Compass: Clinically Relevant Review for Practicing Ophthalmologists* will be removed from the Ophthalmic News and Education (ONE<sup>™</sup>) Network on 14 February.

In mid-February, a new online product, the *Practicing Ophthalmologists Learning System* will be available for purchase on the ONE Network. This new study tool is ideal for lifelong learning and self-assessment.

**If you have notations in *Compass* that you would like to keep, you must copy and save them to your personal files before 14 February.**

How to access and save your *Compass* notations:

1. [Log in to Compass.](#)
2. Select "My Notebook" in the left-side navigation.
3. Choose a subspecialty.
4. Select the section in which you have input content (Bookmarks, Highlights and/or Notes).
5. Select "Review Outline."
6. Select the content you would like to save.
7. Use the print icon to print and save your content.

**NOTE:** If you have content in multiple locations, you will need to repeat steps 2 through 7 for each selection you would like to save.
